

ATTACHMENT 2 CROP MONITORING RECORD TEMPLATE

This form should be filled out by approved crop monitors to certify that orchards have been found free from mango seed weevil, orange fruit borer and bacterial black spot, and have been monitored for pests of quarantine concern to China. Crop monitoring must occur at least once every 2 weeks, with the exception of growers which utilise a systems approach to managing mango seed weevil, which must be undertaken weekly from when fruit are approx. 3 cm long. Sample regime is detailed below, which is also for orchards using systems approach to demonstrate orchard freedom from mango seed weevil.
